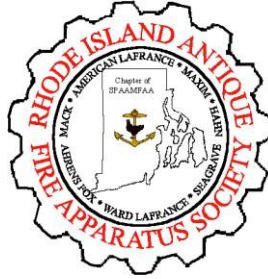

The Rhode Island Antique Fire Apparatus Society, Inc. (RIAFAS), is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization that was formed in May 2004. Our main goal is to promote and foster a spirit of friendliness and cooperation among our members who are dedicated to preserving and displaying the history of vintage firefighting apparatus and equipment. RIAFAS members display their antique apparatus in parades, meets, and musters, while aiding each other in the rehabilitation of vintage fire equipment. We institute and present fire prevention and educational displays to the public, maintain association meeting facilities, and we are the only SPAAMFAA chapter in Rhode Island.

SPAAMFAA is the acronym for the Society for the Preservation and Appreciation of Antique Motor Fire Apparatus in America. Founded in New York in 1958, SPAAMFAA is an organization dedicated to the preservation, restoration, and operation of antique fire fighting apparatus.

RIAFAS members are a special group of firefighting enthusiasts who enjoy getting together to talk about antique fire apparatus, history and tradition. RIAFAS is open to all individuals; you do not need to own an antique fire apparatus fire engine, live in Rhode Island, or be a member of SPAAMFAA. RIAFAS members are very involved in their chapter - an average of thirty members attend every meeting.
